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Certificate in Service Learning

1. Complete 2 (6 hours) service learning courses from the [pre-approved list](#).
2. Accumulate 60 hours of service, including what was required for service learning courses
 - Other ways to complete hours include participating in alternative break trip or volunteering at a non-profit agency
3. Complete a reflection (2 options)
 - Attend on 50-minute reflection session
 - Write reflection summary including all service experiences

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Certificate of Entrepreneurship

Open to undergraduate and graduate students

- Required Courses
 - ENTR 301 or 701: Starting your own business
 - ENTR 302 or 702: Financing your own business
 - ENTR 303 or 703: Marketing your own business
- Final Capstone Course (3 Options)
 - Option A: Take 4th course through your school of origin. Speak with advisor to find suitable course. Must be approved by Center for Entrepreneurship.
 - Option B: ENTR 490
 - Option C: Take independent study course through School of Business
- Additional Requirements
 - Submit complete business plan
 - [Apply for Certification Graduation](#) through Enroll & Pay
 - Earn C or better in all courses
 - *Graduate students:* Complete [Graduate Application](#)

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Arts Engagement Certificate

1. Take Classes

Take at least 2 arts classes (6 hours) from different departments.

- Architecture
- Dance
- Design
- Creative Writing
- Film and Media Studies
- History of Art
- Honors classes taught by arts faculty
- Music
- Theatre
- Visual Art



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2. Experience the Arts (2 Options)

• Path A

~Attend 6 art events from 3 different arts areas. Example: 2 dance performances, 2 design lectures, and 2 visual art exhibitions. Write a reflection over each event.

• Path B

~Attend 3 art events from 3 different arts areas. Write a reflection over each event.

~Complete a semester long, hands-on arts experience. Examples:

- A third class with a “studio” focus (actively making, doing, producing, performing, etc. creative works). ***Different school/department than the 2 classes used to fulfill the coursework requirement***
- Arts related internship
- Participating in campus music, theatre, or dance productions.

~Complete a short written reflection and submit some kind of artifact from your experience.

3. Final Written Reflection

~Answer 6 written reflection essay questions and take a short exit questionnaire.

Global Awareness Program

Complete 2 components to earn certificate. Complete all 3 to earn certificate with distinction.

Academic Courses

• U.S. Students

- 2 semesters of same modern, foreign language
- 3 courses with a modern, international focus from 3 different departments (2 departments for students in STEM)

• International Students

- Pass English Proficiency Exam or receive English requirement waiver
- 2 courses with modern international focus + 1 humanities or social science course

International Experience

• U.S. Students

- Participate in Study Abroad program arranged by KU
- Respond to reflection questions
- OR participate in another international experience that is at least one month long and is pursued while at KU

• International Students

- Study at KU automatically accepted as international experience
- Answer reflection questions about time at KU

Cultural Activities

- Participate in 20 hours of campus activities that have international and/or cultural focus
- Document hours in ePortfolio and respond to reflection questions



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
